NJROTC Behavioral Contract

All Virginia State and Stafford County rules and regulations will be in effect and strictly followed.

- 1. I will do my best to abide by the Navy Core Values: "Honor, Courage and Commitment."
 - a. <u>Honor</u>: To conduct myself in the highest ethical manner in all relationships with my peers, seniors and subordinates. To be truthful and honest, taking responsibility for my actions.
 - b. <u>Courage:</u> To have the strength of character to make decisions in the best interest of myself, my family, my friends, Brooke Point H.S. and the NJROTC unit without regard to personal consequences. To make the right choices even in the face of opposition.
 - c. <u>Commitment:</u> To dedicate myself to the highest moral and ethical standards. To be committed to positive change and continual improvement. To commit myself to service to others.
- 2. I will wear a complete, clean NJROTC uniform when required by my Naval Science Instructors; usually weekly.
 - a. I understand that if the uniform is not worn when required, I will receive a "zero" for that inspection grade.
 - b. I understand that on prescribed uniform days a complete uniform <u>must</u> be worn **ALL** day. Failure to do so **will result** in a reduction to my inspection grade.
 - c. I understand that civilian clothing is not to be worn with the NJROTC Uniform.
 - d. I understand that I will wear my uniform as required by the NJROTC Field Manual.
- 3. When in uniform, all cadets <u>will</u> conform to the personal grooming standards described in the NJROTC Cadet Field Manual. For example:
 - a. Males: will not wear earrings or any body piercing jewelry, will be clean-shaven (properly groomed moustaches allowed), will wear their hair in accordance with military standards (no corn rows, braids or "bizarre" hair styles.
 - b. Females: will wear only one earring per ear (gold or silver post) and no other body piercing jewelry. Hair and nails must conform to the standards of the NJROTC Field Manual.
- 4. I will do my best to conduct myself in an appropriate manner at ALL times.
 - a. Inappropriate personal behavior, whether in any classroom or at NJROTC/Brooke Point H.S. sponsored events will be dealt with by the NJROTC instructors on a case by case basis.
 - Excessive disregard of NJROTC behavioral standards or the continual need for school discipline (STOP, detention, ISS or OSS) will result in a recommendation for dismissal from the NJROTC program.
- 5. I will be especially respectful to my parents, teachers and other adults; displaying good manners and helping whenever I can.
- 6. I will treat ALL people with dignity and respect.
- 7. I will respect the American Flag and the NJROTC uniform.
- 8. I will faithfully attend school and all my classes unless I have a bona fide emergency, illness, or excused absence.

I understand that violations of this contract will result in restrictions from NJROTC activities, impact on the military bearing portion of my grade, and may result in other disciplinary action; including possible removal from the program.
